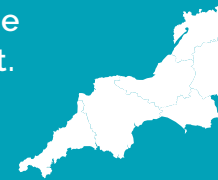


81% of veterans are in paid employment. This is higher than the current UK employment rate of 75%.

Where veterans choose to live has a major impact on finding the right job.



The most popular place for veterans to live is the South West.



24% of respondents live there.

27% of female respondents described the experience of finding the right job as 'very difficult', but for male respondents, this was just 17%.



78% of veterans were willing to commute up to an hour. Considerably less than the average commute for London workers.



More than half of veterans found their actual salaries differed from pre-transition expectations.

30% of veterans from Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland were earning less or considerably less than they hoped.

48% of veterans living in London found their salary goals higher than expected.



70% of veterans under 30 said the most important factor for them when searching for a civilian job was 'career progression'.
